

1. In accordance with the procedures at reference, EADRCC has received today, 27 March 2020, a request for international assistance. The following information was provided.

#### 2. General Situation

Type of the Disaster : COVID-19 pandemic

Date and Time the Disaster occurred : Ongoing Location of the Disaster : Albania

#### 3. Initial Assessment of the damage and description of the situation

- 3.1. On March 23<sup>rd</sup> 2020, the Albanian Government declared the state of natural disaster emergency due to the outbreak of COVID-19. As of today, in Albania, we have 174 confirmed cases of COVID-19, more than 70 people are hospitalized, and 8 citizens have died. The overall rate of the pandemic in Albania is 6/100 000 citizens, whereas in the municipality of Tirana it is 17/100 000 citizens.
- 3.2. Most of the confirmed cases are in the capital city of Tirana, followed by the regions of Fier, Durrës, Korça and fewer cases are detected in other districts of Albania. The entire country is in lockdown and strict measures to isolate the spread of the virus are in place.

- 3.3. We have dedicated one area for quarantine with 120 beds and we are in the process of rehabilitating another building and transforming it into a quarantine with 100 beds. We have two dedicated hospitals to treat patients with COVID-19 with a capacity of around 480 beds.
- 3.4. We are expecting a rapid growth of confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the next few weeks. In order to prevent the spread of the virus among the medical staff, front line staff and the citizens, we kindly ask our international partners to provide assistance to the Ministry of Health and Social Protection in the response to the global pandemic.
